SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR PERMIT TE208532-1

1. All applicable portions of Title 50 Code of Federal Regulations §§ 13, 17.22, or 17.32 (Attachments) are conditions of this permit. If any such regulations are modified, any future action taken with respect to this permit and related Certificates of Inclusion shall be in accordance with such regulations in existence at the time such action is taken, except as otherwise specifically provided for by law.
2. The authorization granted by this permit and related Certificates of Inclusion is subject to full and complete compliance with the Willamette Valley Native Prairie Habitat Programmatic Safe Harbor Agreement for the Fender's Blue Butterfly (Agreement) and Appendices, which are hereby incorporated by reference into this permit.
3. The Permittee and Certificate of Inclusion holders shall be responsible for ensuring compliance with this permit and the Agreement by any authorized officer, employee, contractor, or agent while conducting covered activities in accordance with site plans approved by the Permittee. All applicable provisions of this permit must be presented and clearly explained to all authorized officers, employees, contractors, or agents of the Permittee and Certificate of Inclusion holders conducting covered activities on enrolled lands.
4. The Permittee and Certificate of Inclusion holders and their authorized officers, employees, contractors, and agents are authorized, pursuant to section 10(a)(1)(A) of the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended, to incidentally take the endangered Fender's blue butterfly (*Icaricia icarioides fenderi*) on enrolled lands in conjunction with covered activities in accordance with section 11 of the Agreement.
5. The Permittee is not required to obtain a new permit if there is a change in the legal individual or business name, or in the mailing address. Within 10 calendar days of such change, the Permittee is required to notify the issuing office (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Regional Office, Division of Endangered Species, 911 Northeast 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon 97232). This provision does not authorize any change in location of the conduct of the permitted activity when approval of the location is a qualifying condition of the permit.
6. A Certificate of Inclusion holder is not required to obtain a new Certificate of Inclusion if there is a change in the legal individual or business name, or in the mailing address. Within 10 calendar days of such change, the Certificate of Inclusion holder is required to notify the issuing office (U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Oregon Fish and Wildlife Office, 2600 SE 98<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Suite 100, Portland, Oregon 97266). This provision does not authorize any change in location of the conduct of the activity covered by the Certificate of Inclusion when approval of the location is a qualifying condition of the Certificate of Inclusion.
