



How to Link Products to a Project

This module shows how the Reference owner can bundle one or more References as associated Products with a Project Reference.

General Steps

Step 1. Create a Product Reference

Create references for each of the Products following the standard process of creating References. Be sure to activate the Product Reference.

Step 2. Create a Project Reference

Create the Project Reference following the standard process and ensure it is active as well.

Step 3. Edit the Project and Link to Products

Edit the Project and add the related Products. Do this by either specifying the Reference Codes or searching by text.
