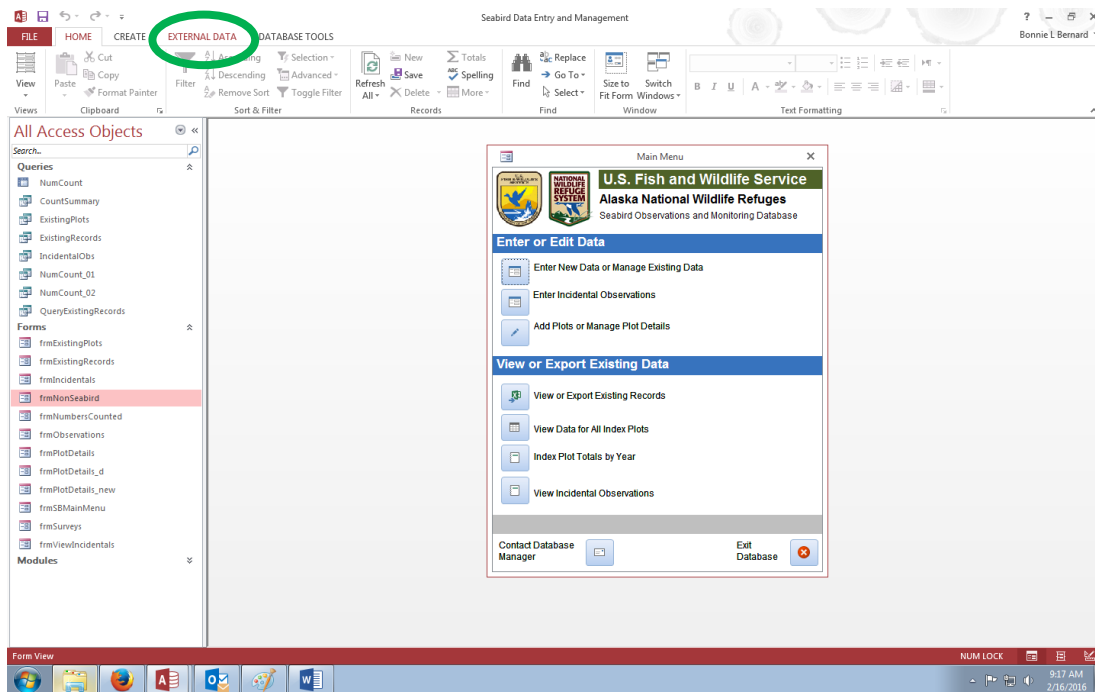
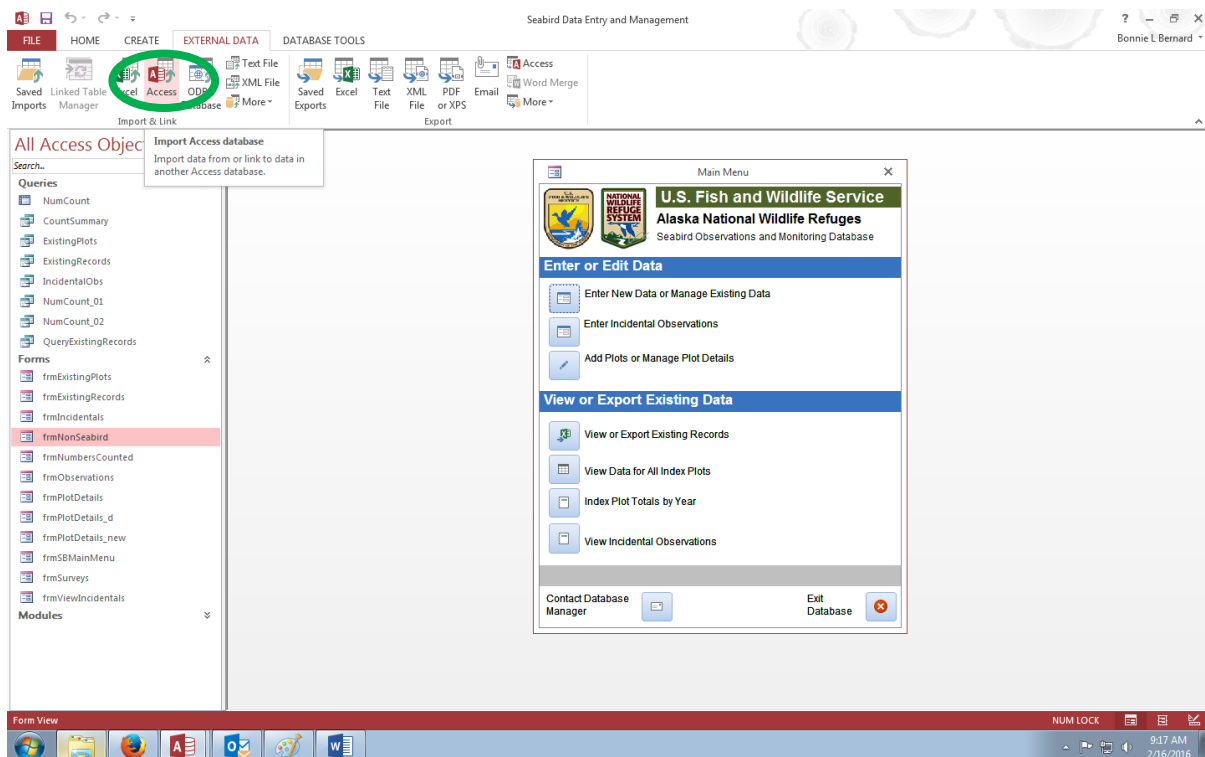


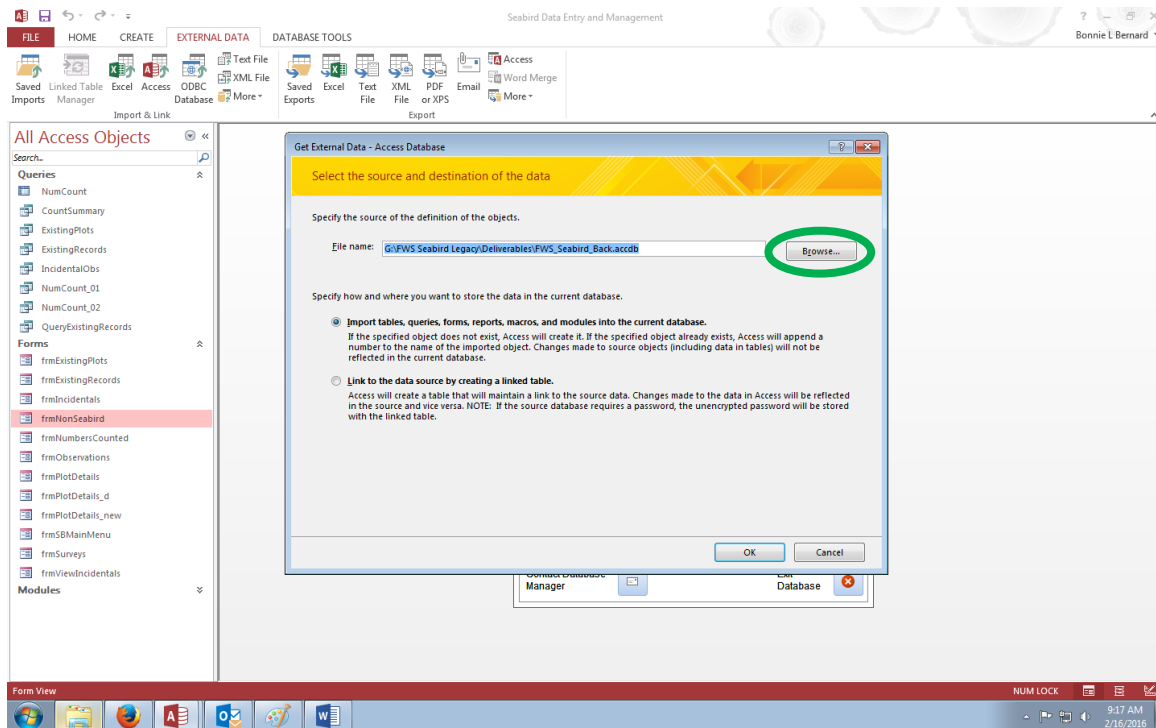
1. Open the Seabird Database Interface (front end)
2. Click the "External Data" tab at the top of the MS Access Screen.



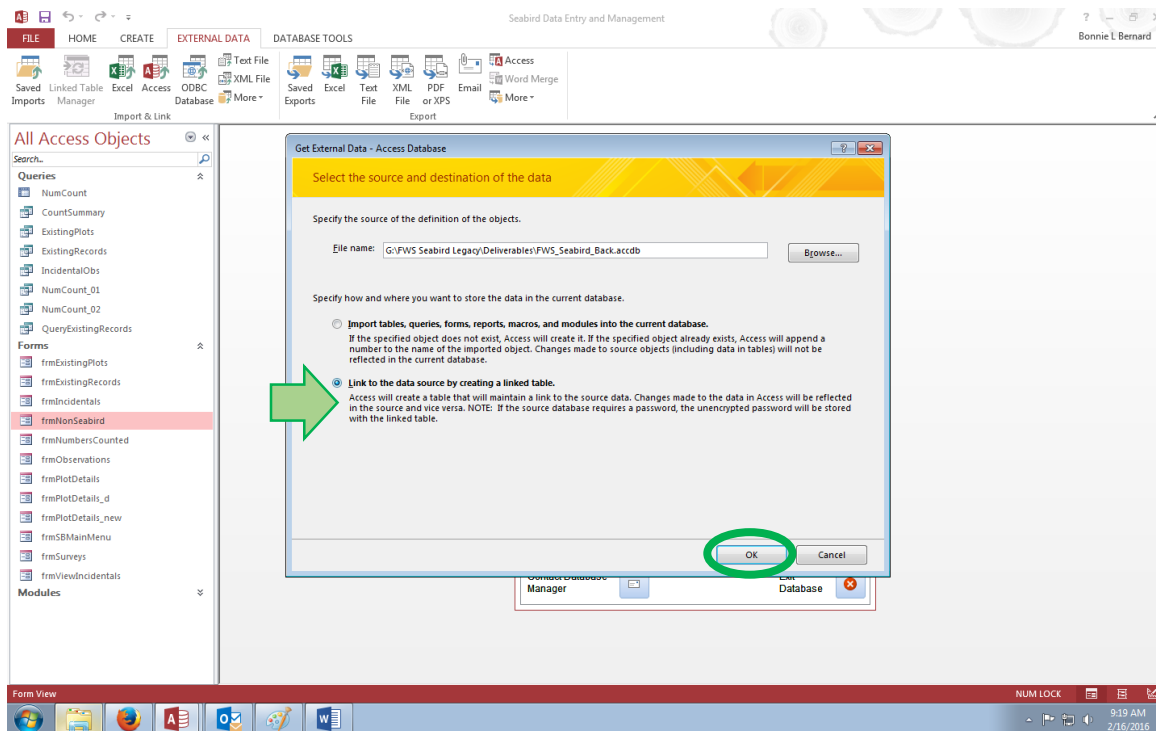
3. In the "Import & Link" Category at left, click the "Access" button



4. Find the Seabird Database (back end) using the browse function

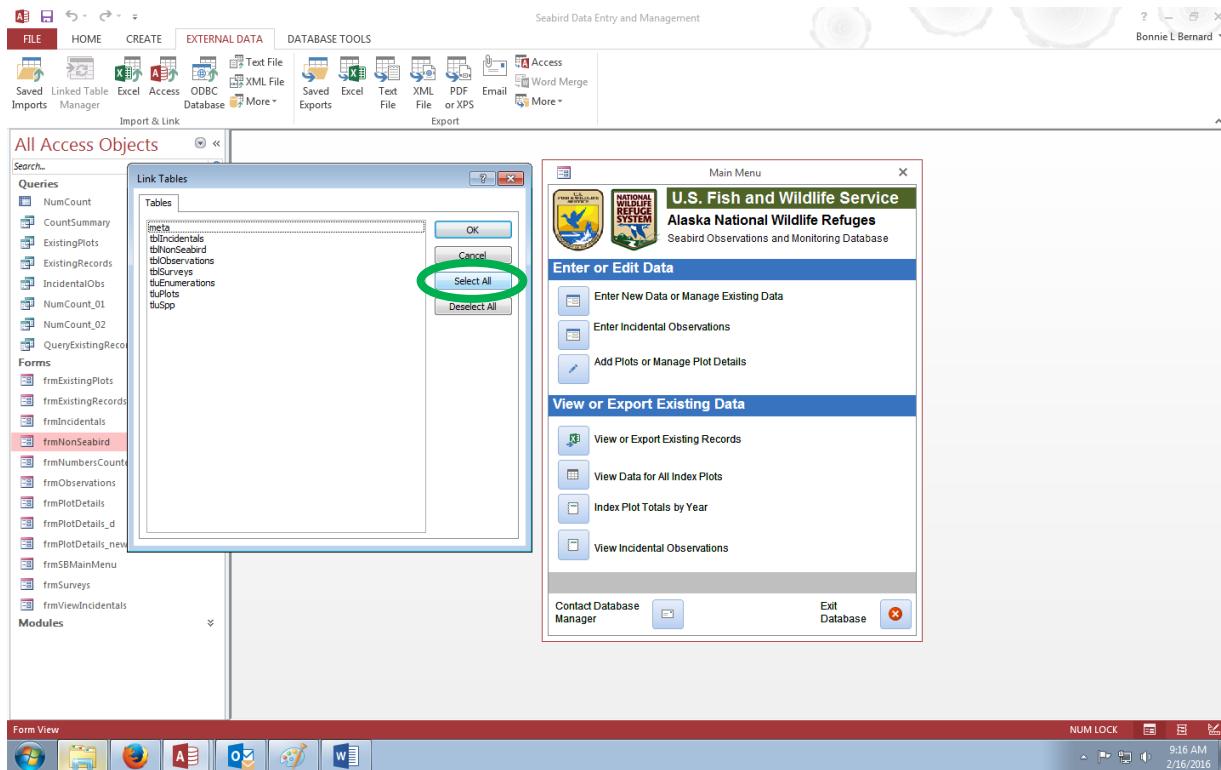


5. Select the "Link to the data source by creating a linked table" radio button

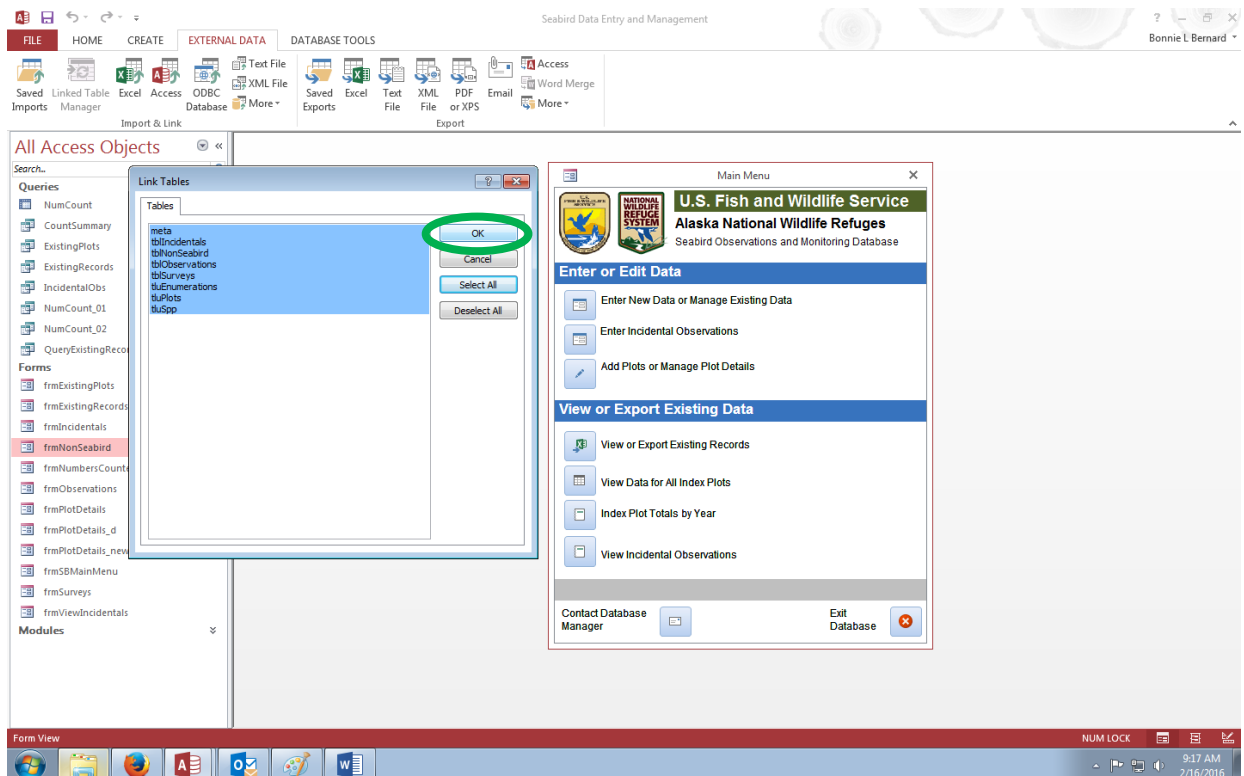


6. Click "OK"
