Thanks for sending the information along. There are several interesting butterflies on you list:

Thymelicus lineola the European Skipper is a western extension by several counties.

<u>Problema byssus</u> the Bysus Skipper is a very good catch and a tight prairie obligate. This skipper is tough to id unless you have a female. You can measure your successes by it and the larval grass foodplant is unknown in Iowa.

<u>Euphyes</u> <u>dion</u> is a marsh (sedge) butterfly, a great find. The Harvester is good (I have never seen one in the wild).

The Hickory Hairstreak <u>Satyrium caryaevorum</u> is good and very hard to identify, we need a number of identified specimens for comparison to make a determination.

S. <u>liparops</u> is quite rare and believed to use plum.

Several of these have caused us much consternation as they are easily confused with other species. I don't have Erv Klaas' address but I would like to see the specimens above, where are they housed and how might we see them? Jerry Selby might also be able to check these out for us. I would very much like to use the records for the Iowa data but I don't know the expertise of your investigators. (As if I sent you a plant list!) I also need date information and location to section is our usual.

You are off to a great start with the butterflies, congratulations! Could I obtain a copy of the plan you are using.
