1970 AQUATIC TRANSPLANTING PROGRAM

The 1970 aquatic transplant program started on June 11, 1970 with a collecting trip to Reelfoot Lake.

A boat load of sago and American Pond weed was collected on this date and planted in Wapanocca Lake the following day (June 12, 1970).

American Pond weed was planted through out Willowpole, and at marked locations in Round Pond and Little Duck Hole.

Sago was planted in the wave braker enclosure at the south end of the Lake and in Round Pond and Little Duck Hole.

These were the only sections, except the open Lake itself, thought to be suitable for transplanting at this time due to the extensive duck weed and algae growth.
