CHESAPEAKE BAY BALD EAGLE BREEDING SUCCESS - 1979

In the 1979 nesting season the breeding population of bald eagles in the Chesapeake Bay region numbered 85 active pairs. An active pair is one in which the female laid eggs. One female laid eggs in two nests; the first was abandoned and the second produced one young. Of the 86 active nests found 42 were abandoned and 44 hatched 67 young for a hatching success ratio of 0.79 young per active nest. Table I compares nest success data for 1979 with previous years. The map shows the approximate locations of nests and unmated or non-nesting adult birds.

Five of the 67 hatched young disappeared before fledging, including the only young in two Maryland nests and one of two eaglets from one nest in Maryland and two nests in Virginia. Three captive raised young reared to an age of 3 to 6 weeks at the Patuxent Wildlife Research Center were added to three active Virginia nests each of which had a "wild" young. All were accepted and apparently fledged.

In addition to the 85 actively nesting pairs one or two adult bald eagles were seen during the nesting season in 21 other nest sites (see map). The nests seen in these sites were inactive (i.e. not used for egg laying in 1979). In two cases adults were seen carrying nest materials but the nests were not found. In several instances only one adult was seen at or near an inactive nest and probably indicated unmated birds. In six cases where a pair of adults was frequently seen but no active nest found, we assume that these pairs did not lay eggs in 1979. We have a number of pairs that do not lay eggs every year but skip a year now and then while other pairs lay eggs every year with varying success. Table II illustrates this point by indicating nesting results at selected nest sites over selected years since 1936 when the first nesting survey was done in this region. The author has chosen only those nest sites where nesting activity has occurred continuously or sporadically since the 1936 survey. Obviously, the pair that nested at a site in 1936

is not the same pair that nested in the site in 1979. Eagles may live as long as 30 years in the wild but don't mate until 4-5 years of age and probably become impotent after 20+ years. Therefor, when one mate dies the remaining mate picks another partner, often a younger and more virile individual, as in the 1978 Fairfax Co., Va. nest (Table II).

For reasons not yet known, Maryland eagles continue to have better nesting results than those in Virginia. Of 47 active Maryland nests 21 (44%) were abandoned and 26 (56%) hatched 41 young (0.89 yng per active nest). In Virginia of 36 active nests, 21 (56%) were abandoned and 16 (44%) hatched 24 young (0.66 yng per active nest).

In Delaware only two active nests were found (3 in 1978) but both produced an eaglet whereas in 1978 all three were abandoned.

Table III is a complete listing of observations made at all Chesapeake Bay bald eagle nest sites by members of the Chesapeake Region Eagle Group(CREG). This group comprises representatives of the Federal and State Fish & Wildlife or Natural Resources agencies as well as representatives of non government organizations, such as the Audubon Naturalist Society.

Three of the unhatched eagle eggs that were collected in 1979 were analyzed for organochlorines and mercury at the Patuxent Wildlife Research Center. Table IV summarizes these results.

Comments: Contaminant levels of the 1979 Mason Neck egg were quite high; it is surprising that this nest was productive in 1979 (a second egg hatched and the yng fledged). Assuming little intra-clutch variation in contaminant levels, these levels should have been high enough to cause reproductive failure.

The contaminant levels in the 1977 Mason Neck egg were obviously much higher than in 1979. The 1977 female apparently died later as the mate had a young (some brown feathers in the head) female in the 1978 season and her 1978 egg hatched.

The contaminant levels in the Romancoke/^{egg} Wye among the lowest for any Va. egg analyzed thru 1979. Based on current evidence, such high DDE levels might be adequate to cause a depression of reproductive success for a population to or below the stability level of 0.7 yng/active nest.

Contaminant levels in the Wye Hgts egg were quite low and should not have had any appreciable adverse effect on hatching success. This nest successfully produced 1 or 2 yng in the previous 4 years, so some other factor may have caused abandonment.

Mercury levels in all eggs were low and should have had no adverse impact on reproductive success.
