

Meeting

4, 1979

Bill has waded across the Tustumena River
Meeting bottom Kevin Appar
and Bill Bobcat
in mid-late June. He crossed the
braided portion half way, roughly, between the
lake & glacier - widest part of river.

It was thigh to waist deep & he crossed
at 5-6 am for low flow. It was
high water time. He thought there were
cairns for horse crossing where he crossed.

Glacier Cr. was almost dry - no problem in
crossing (clear water).

Lakes (1558' & 1496') adjacent Tustumena Glacier
are accessible by existing horse trail. He
saw 15-20 horses & people on guided trip
up Tustumena.

Existing trail from Tustumena delta along north
& east shore of Tustumena lake.

Goat hunters take Clear Cr. trail to
alpine area between it & Fox R.

He has descended from Harding Icefield, getting
off the glacier about where the map
(Kewai A-2) ends on the south side
& liked paralleling it down to his crossing
point. See portion of his route on map.

He personally sees nothing wrong with trail as
far as its desirability - he's in favor of people
getting outdoors, hunts on McKinley, etc. etc.
