Wild Populations

Aransas - Wood Buffalo Population (AWBP)

The AWBP has been expanding numerically and geographically for some time. In 2011-12, the Service began to modify survey techniques on the winter grounds to provide a standardized, statistically significant estimate rather than attempting a complete count of every individual, which has become increasingly unrealistic. During the 2011-12 winter, surveys were further complicated by changes in personnel, early drought conditions which caused birds to utilize non-traditional areas, and inclement weather, hampering flights. The table below provides the best available data for the AWBP for this period. However, it should not be interpreted as a complete count – based on sighting reports, we suspect there were additional birds in non-traditional areas but we have no way of unconditionally reconciling those reports with survey information.
