These areas lying north of Fort Niebrara serve as little value to waterfowl. At no time during the season were there more than 20 ducks on either area.

Both areas afford protection to the pheasants, but protection of these birds in not a problem in that section.

Parties living on these two places are very much interested in wildlife and are trying to do everything possible to have the units operate to the best possible advantage, but being in such close proximity to the ranch buildings detracts considerable from their value.
