Ruffed Grouse Drumming Survey

Reporting Office: Seney NWR

Species: Ruffed Grouse (Bonasa umbellus)

JUSTIFICATION AND OBJECTIVES

As a cooperative effort with the Michigan DNR, the refuge is asked to participate in a spring drumming survey, which it has done for decades. Seney NWR has data on this species for 1991-present. Route #154 is surveyed, with some other areas surveyed in the past.

STATISTICAL CONSIDERATIONS

None known.

DATA COLLECTION PROCEDURES

The Michigan DNR provides detailed instructions each year for the spring survey, which consists of stopping at 10 stops in the refuge to listen for drumming birds over a fixed time period (3-5 minutes).
