Mr. HASKELL (for Mr. JACKSON) (for himself and Mr. FANNIN) (by request)
introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the
Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs

A BILL

To designate certain lands in the J. N. "Ding" Darling National
Wildlife Refuge, Lee County, Florida, as wilderness.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That, in accordance with section 3 (c) of the Wilderness Act
4 of September 3, 1964 (78 Stat. 890, 892; 16 U.S.C.
5 1132 (c)), certain lands in the J. N. "Ding" Darling Na-
6 tional Wildlife Refuge, Florida, which comprise about two
7 thousand seven hundred and thirty-five acres and which are
8 depicted on a map entitled "J. N. 'Ding' Darling Wilderness
9 Proposal" dated January 1974, are hereby designated as
10 wilderness.

1 SEC. 2. As soon as practicable after this Act takes effect,
2 a map of the wilderness area and a description of its bound-
3 aries shall be filed with the Interior and Insular Affairs
4 Committees of the United States Senate and the House of
5 Representatives, and such map and description shall have the
6 same force and effect as if included in this Act: *Provided*,
7 *however*, That correction of clerical and typographical errors
8 in such map and description may be made.

9 SEC. 3. The area designated by this Act as wilderness
10 shall be known as the "J. N. 'Ding' Darling Wilderness"
11 and shall be administered by the Secretary of the Interior
12 in accordance with the applicable provisions of the Wilderness
13 Act governing areas designated by that Act as wilderness
14 areas, and where appropriate any reference in that Act to
15 the Secretary of Agriculture shall be deemed to be a refer-
16 ence to the Secretary of the Interior.

17 SEC. 4. Subject to all valid rights existing on the
18 date of enactment of this Act, lands designated as wilderness
19 by this Act are hereby withdrawn from all forms of appro-
20 priation under the mining laws and from disposition under
21 all laws pertaining to mineral leasing and all amendments
22 thereto.
