Mr. HASKELL (for Mr. JACKSON) (for himself and Mr. FANNIN) (by request)  
introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the  
Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs

## A BILL

To designate certain lands in the Lake Woodruff National Wildlife Refuge, Lake and Volusia Counties, Florida, as wilderness.

- 1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa*
- 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3 That, in accordance with section 3 (c) of the Wilderness Act
- 4 of September 3, 1964 (78 Stat. 890, 892; 16 U.S.C. 1132
- 5 (c)), certain lands in the Lake Woodruff National Wildlife
- 6 Refuge, Florida, which comprise about one thousand one
- 7 hundred and six acres and which are depicted on a map en-
- 8 titled "Lake Woodruff Wilderness Proposal" dated Decem-
- 9 ber 1973, are hereby designated as wilderness. The lands

1 which comprise about forty acres, designated on such map as  
2 "Potential Wilderness Additions", are, effective upon publi-  
3 cation in the Federal Register of a notice by the Secretary of  
4 the Interior that all uses thereon prohibited by the Wilder-  
5 ness Act have ceased, hereby designated as wilderness.

6 SEC. 2. As soon as practicable after this Act takes effect,  
7 a map of the wilderness area and a description of its bound-  
8 aries shall be filed with the Interior and Insular Affairs  
9 Committees of the United States Senate and the House of  
10 Representatives, and such map and description shall have the  
11 same force and effect as if included in this Act: *Provided,*  
12 *however,* That correction of clerical and typographical errors  
13 in such map and description may be made.

14 SEC. 3. The area designated by this Act as wilderness  
15 shall be known as the "Lake Woodruff Wilderness" and shall  
16 be administered by the Secretary of the Interior in accord-  
17 ance with the applicable provisions of the Wilderness Act  
18 governing areas designated by that Act as wilderness areas,  
19 and where appropriate any reference in that Act to the Sec-  
20 retary of Agriculture shall be deemed to be a reference to the  
21 Secretary of the Interior.

22 SEC. 4. Subject to all valid rights existing on the date of  
23 enactment of this Act, lands designated as Wilderness by this  
24 Act are hereby withdrawn from all forms of appropriation  
25 under the mining laws and from disposition under all laws  
26 pertaining to mineral leasing and all amendments thereto.
