Hello Marilyn:

Enclosed is our report of nest boxes on and in the vicinity of the refuge. There were three nesting attempts by kestrels this past year, but only one was successful, for a total of 4 young fledged. All three of the adult female kestrels that bred at Wallkill in 2014 were captured and identified: we banded and tagged the female at WK15, the female at WK16 had been banded and tagged as an adult at WK15 in 2013, and the female at WK17 was foreign banded. We never observed a male at either WK15 or WK16, the two nests that failed. We did capture and mark the male at WK17, the nest that fledged 4 young.

A total of 25 breeding attempts occurred at the 18 nest boxes (WK01, WK06-07, WK09-12, WK14-19, WK22-23, WK26, WK31, and WK33) that were available during the 2014 breeding season. Three pairs of kestrels breed, but only one was successful.


