2013 - 2014 Harvest Recommendations:

Harvest on this refuge looks to be the most balanced of any so far. Harvest and data reporting has improved significantly on this NWR in the last 3 years. Doe body weights are equal to or slightly below the Delta average, but yearling and fawn weights are now beginning to become closer to average. Since nutritional stress impacts younger deer first, this supports the need for more intense antlerless harvest. Reduced weights may also be related to limited access to quality browse because of

the wet habitat on this NWR. Realistically, a doe per 324 acres does not approach compensating for the annual fawn crop. The doe age structure appears to be shifted to younger age classes, with 49% of the harvest being 3-years old or older. Obviously, the fact that 11 doe fawns were taken shifted the age structure. If the adult age structure is adjusted with fawns removed, this percentage increases to 54% 3-years old or older. The goal of population management is to get this percentage to 40 or less. Once the population is reduced to this level, antler production, body condition, and fawn production are maximized. Overall, the deer herd on Hillside appears to be in good condition, but, given the current hunting regime, the herd health is not likely to be sustainable. As deer herds exceed carrying capacity, they impact herbaceous plant communities, which then impact other wildlife species. Ideally, harvest should be increased to target taking at least a doe per 150 acres of deer habitat or **100-125 does**. However unlikely this may be, that is my recommendation.

Buck harvest is very sound for a public property. Buck harvest continues to be focused on 2 & 3-year old bucks with 84% of the buck harvest being 3-years old or younger. This harvest strategy is biologically sound and fun, as long as the limitations are realized. The production of large antlered bucks will be limited because very few bucks are making it to 4, 5, and 6 years of age. As long as this limitation is understood, I have no problem with the current harvest. The harvested 2 & 3-year olds had great potential if allowed to reach maturity (Table 9). However, if hunters are pleased with the current buck quality, then continue using the current harvest strategy. If you decide that you want to target larger antlered bucks, please feel free to contact me.

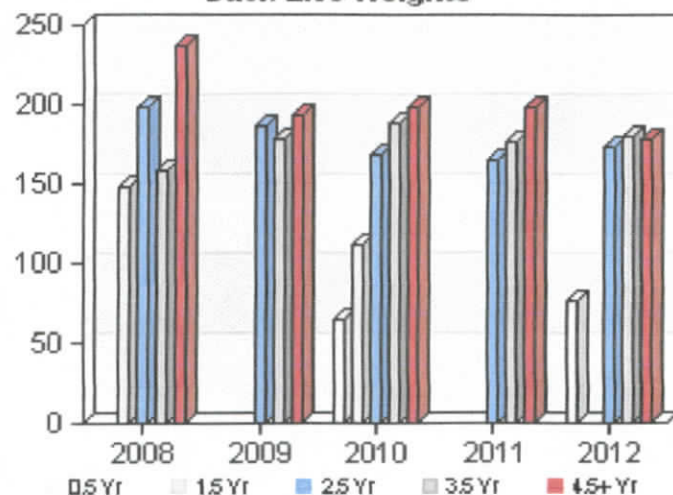
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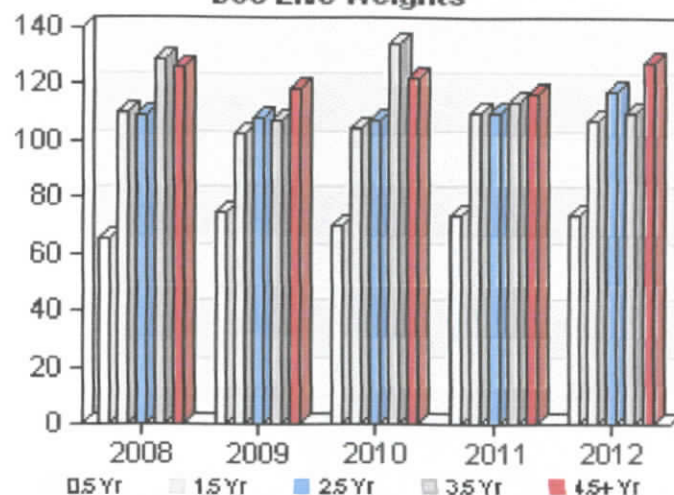

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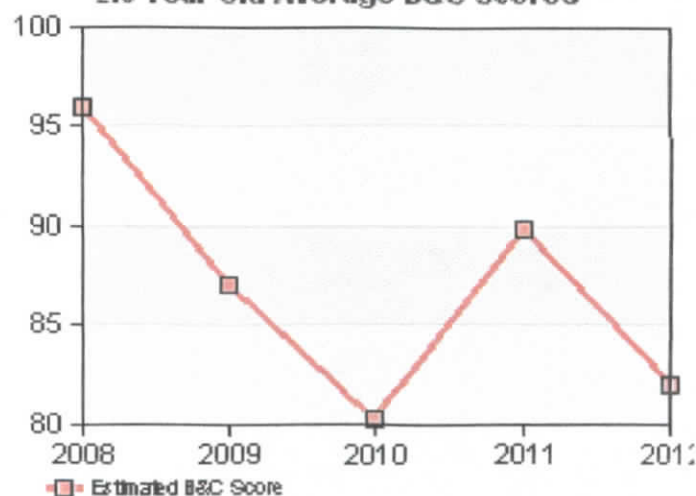
Buck Live Weights



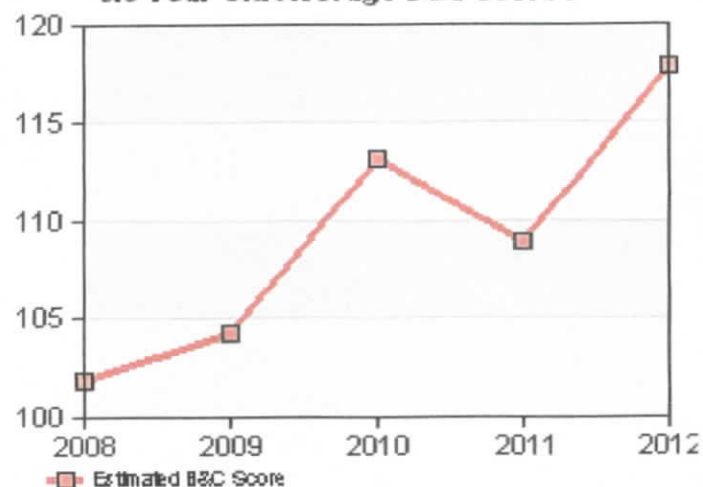
Doe Live Weights



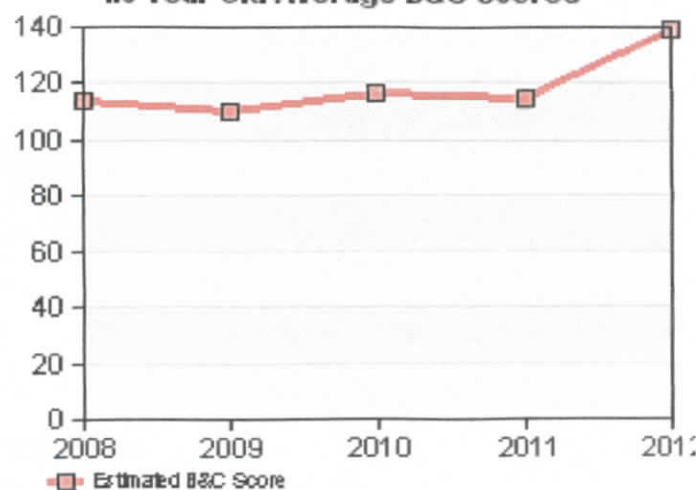
2.5 Year Old Average B&C Scores
