The following-described tract of land is located in Becker County, Minnesota, approximately twenty-three miles northeasterly of the City of Detroit Lakes, Minnesota, being part of the land described in Public Law 94-557, (90 Stat. 2633), dated October 19, 1976, and described according to the public land surveys:

Township One Hundred Forty-one (141) North, Range Thirty-nine (39) West, Fifth Principal Meridian: In section three (3), all of lots two (2), three (3), four (4), and five (5), together with those parts of lots one (1), six (6), seven (7), and eight (8) lying northwesterly of the existing Forest Service road; and in

Township One Hundred Forty-two (142) North, Range Thirty-nine (39) West, Fifth Principal Meridian: In section twenty-six (26), that part of the South Half (S_2^1) lying westerly of County Road No. 35;

In section twenty-seven (27), the South Half (S_2^1) ;

In section thirty-four (34), all;

In section thirty-five (35), that part lying westerly of County Road No. 35;

In section thirty-six (36), that part lying westerly of County Road No. 35 and northerly of the Forest Service road; and in
