CONDITIONS AND AUTHORIZATIONS FOR PERMIT PRT-777837

- D. Acceptance of this permit serves as evidence that the permittee understands and agrees to abide by the "Special Conditions for Marine Mammals and Native Endangered and Threatened Species" (copy attached).
- E. The permittee is authorized to incidentally take up to twenty (20) northern spotted owls (Strix occidentalis caurina) for the first 10 years of this permit and up to ten (10) spotted owls per decade for the remaining 90 years of this permit, in the course of otherwise lawful timber harvest activities, as described in the permittee's application and supporting documents, and as conditioned herein.
- F. The authorization granted by this permit is subject to full and complete compliance with, and implementation of, the Habitat Conservation Plan and Implementation Agreement executed by Murray Pacific Corporation and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. The Habitat Conservation Plan and Implementation Agreement are incorporated by reference as terms and conditions of the permit.
