Special Terms and Conditions for Permit TE67854B-0

- E. Acceptance of this permit serves as evidence that the permittee and its authorized agents understand and agree to abide by the terms of this permit and all sections of Title 50 Code of Federal Regulations, parts 13 and 17, pertinent to issued permits.
- F. The authorization granted by this permit is subject to full and complete compliance with, and implementation of, the Safe Harbor Agreement and implementing agreement executed by the permittee and the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service. This permit, the Safe Harbor Agreement, and implementing agreement are binding upon the permittee and any authorized officer, employee, contractor, or agent conducting permitted activities.
- G. The permittee and its authorized officers, employees, contractors, or agents are authorized to incidentally take the northern spotted owl (*Strix occidentalis caurina*) and the marbled murrelet (*Brachyramphus marmoratus*) in the course of conducting otherwise lawful forest management activities and incidental tree removal associated with utility maintenance in accordance with the Safe Harbor Agreement, implementing agreement, and the permit.
- H. The permittee will notify the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington Fish and Wildlife Office, within fourteen working days if new locations of nesting northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets are discovered on the covered lands.
- I. Upon locating any injured or sick individuals of northern spotted owls or marbled murrelets, permittee will notify the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington Fish and Wildlife Office, within one working day. Upon locating any dead northern spotted owls or dead marbled murrelets, notification will be within five working days. Instructions for proper handling and disposition of such specimens will be provided at that time.
- J. Reports submitted in compliance with this permit must include the following certification from a responsible official who supervised or directed the preparation of the report:
- “Under penalty of law, I certify that, to the best of my knowledge, after appropriate inquiries of all relevant persons involved in the preparation of this report, the information submitted is true, accurate, and complete.”
